

The 4th Chinese Culture Experience Camp

Our students, 3C Sing Kwan Yui Darren and 4D Wei Xinyu Yannie, participated in the 4th "Chinese Culture Experience Camp" from 14 to 16 July 2026. Organised by New Asia College, The Chinese University of Hong Kong, and sponsored by the Tin Ka Ping Foundation, the camp allowed our students to immerse themselves in Chinese culture on the CUHK campus.

The camp kicked off with a visit to the CUHK Art Museum, followed by a Tai Chi workshop where students experienced the harmonious balance of strength and flexibility inherent in traditional martial arts. At the welcome dinner that evening, they were treated to up-close Face-Changing (Bian Lian) performances and live traditional Chinese music. The following day fostered teamwork through campus orienteering and a quiz competition, followed by a fun, hands-on dumpling-making session. Participants also explored traditional heritage from new perspectives through a Chinese opera presentation and a game of Chinese chess. On the final day, professional instructors guided the students in calligraphy and traditional Chinese painting, teaching them to cultivate patience and mindfulness with every brushstroke.

At the closing ceremony, both students were honoured to receive their certificates from Professor Shu Ching Tat, Associate Head of New Asia College, and took commemorative photos with our Principal, Dr. Lau, alongside their teachers. Our school extends its heartfelt gratitude to New Asia College, CUHK, and the Tin Ka Ping Foundation for their excellent organisation.
