To extend students' language and study skills and develop their critical thinking skills through: ➤ a wide range of authentic reading, listening and viewing materials ➤ the teaching of grammar at the sentence and text levels (i.e. sentence building and analysis) ➤ further focused teaching and recycling of vocabulary
