Afterward, they completed game sheets related to the exhibition content. Students who answered correctly were rewarded with gifts, fostering engagement and knowledge retention.
15-19 April	<p>National Security Education Book Fair (<i>School Library</i>)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Co-organised by the Personal, Social, and Humanities Education Key Learning Area, Library, and National Education Committee, the National Security Education Book Fair was held in the school library. Students had access to a curated selection of books and resources that further deepened their understanding of National Security.
