

Form Five Citizenship and Social Development Study Tour: Exploring Guangzhou's Historical Culture and Innovative Technology

To broaden students' horizons, deepen their understanding of our nation, and cultivate a stronger sense of patriotism, our school's Other Learning Experiences Committee joined the "Guangzhou Historical Culture and Innovative Technology Study Tour", organized by the Education Bureau from April 17 to 19, 2025.

During the tour, students gained first-hand insights in China's latest advancements by visiting cutting-edge innovative technology research facilities. The visits highlighted the critical role of technological development in safeguarding national security and cybersecurity, and inspired students to embrace a spirit of exploration, innovation, and curiosity towards technology. Beyond technology, students in the tour were immersed in Guangzhou's rich cultural heritage through visits to historical landmarks such as the Museum of Nanyue King and the Chen Clan Ancestral Hall. By engaging with these sites, students reflected on the preservation and legacy of traditional Chinese culture, and explored ways to incorporate its values into their daily lives. These experiences deepened their appreciation for Chinese heritage and strengthened their national pride and identity.

Additionally, students had the valuable opportunity to interact and collaborate with peers from Guangzhou Xiguan Foreign Language School, fostering cross-cultural exchange. Through discussions, they explored opportunities available to young people in mainland China, gaining fresh perspectives on their future roles in the nation's development. This study tour not only enriched students' learning but also reinforced their connection to China's past, present, and future.
