

HCY A.C.E. (Adventure Collaboration Education) Programme: Australia Study Trip

To broaden students' horizons and cultivate positive values through exchange and service, our school organized the "Australia Adventure Volunteer Study Tour" from February 27 to March 5, 2026. Led by Principal Lau Sui Yee, Assistant Principal Law Lai Ming, and teachers Mr. Leung Wa and Mr. Tam Pok Man, 36 students from Secondary 4 and Secondary 5 participated in this meaningful journey. The program was designed to promote positive thinking and a heart of gratitude through service experiences, effectively equipping students with the resilience to face various challenges in their personal growth.

Beyond volunteer work at local elderly homes, the itinerary featured academic exchanges with local schools to facilitate cross-regional learning and enhance students' communication skills. These interactions provided the group with a deeper understanding of Australian teaching and learning models. To further enrich their cultural perspective, students also visited iconic landmarks such as the University of Melbourne, the Twelve Apostles, and the State Library of Victoria to gain a comprehensive appreciation of Australian history and culture.
