

## Honour in “Pet Love Pavilion Education Promotion Recognition Scheme 2025”

Our school was honoured with a commendation in the “Pet Love Pavilion Education Promotion Recognition Scheme 2025,” recognising our efforts and achievements in promoting STEAM and life education. Since 2024, the Biology Department has established the “Chameleon Pet Love Pavilion” on campus and begun caring for a chameleon named “Dun Dun,” providing students with hands-on opportunities to care for and observe animals. Through this experience, students develop a sense of responsibility, empathy, and scientific curiosity.

Students are responsible for daily care duties, including monitoring temperature and humidity, providing food, and cleaning the enclosure. Through these tasks, they gain an in-depth understanding of animal behaviour and husbandry techniques, while also applying interdisciplinary knowledge and research methods. Students introduce the chameleon’s living habits to community visitors and share their experiences in caring for it, thereby enhancing their presentation and communication skills. At the same time, they explain the chameleon’s characteristics and conservation significance to visiting primary school students. Through interaction with guests, students strengthen their communication abilities and build confidence as well as clear and effective self-expression.
