

HCY A.C.E. (Adventure•Collaboration•Education) Programme:

Guizhou Study Trip

The School's Other Learning Experiences Committee organized the "HCY A.C.E. (Adventure, Collaboration, Education) Programme: Guizhou Study Trip" from 21 to 26 March 2026. The tour aimed to enrich students' learning experiences by enabling them to appreciate Guizhou's rich history, ethnic minority cultures, natural landscapes, and astronomical achievements. It also sought to foster national awareness and encourage students to give back to the community through service learning.

During the tour, students visited several iconic attractions in Guizhou, including the Xijiang Qianhu Miao Village, the Wind and Rain Bridge, the Observation Deck, Libo Xiaoqikong, the Wolong River Ecological Corridor, and Libo Daqikong. The itinerary also featured the Pingtang Tianyan Scenic Area, the FAST (Dawodang) Radio Telescope, the Pingtang International Astronomical Experience Centre, and the Sky Screen Cinema. Stargazing activities were arranged alongside visits to the Huangguoshu Waterfall, the Doupotang Waterfall, and the Tianxingqiao Scenic Area. In addition, students visited a local elderly home to conduct community service. They performed for the residents, played games, and engaged in meaningful conversations. These activities helped enhance the students' empathy and strengthened their spirit of service.
